NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES
BY-ELECTION
MUNICIPALITY OF BAY ROBERTS

Nomination of candidates for one (1) councillor for the by-election to the council for the Municipality of Bay Roberts will be received between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. Monday, November 14, 2011, at the Town Hall, Bay Roberts.

The by-election is required and will take place between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, December 6, 2011, at the following polling stations: Bay Roberts Salvation Army Citadel, Grace United Church Hall and Shearstown Lions Club.

Nominations shall be in writing and state the following:

- Name and civic address of the candidate
- Name and civic address of the Proposer and Seconded
- All **three residents must be present** at the Town Hall for the nomination
- The candidate must also sign the nomination document, signifying their acceptance
- In the event that a candidate cannot be present for nomination, the proposer and seconder may complete the paperwork on candidate's behalf
- Every candidate at the time of their nomination shall deposit with the Returning Officer the **non-refundable** sum of ten dollars (\$10.00).

The qualifications of a candidate for election to council are as follows:

1. Canadian Citizen of the full age of eighteen years.
2. Resident of the municipality or in an area that on Election Day is part of the municipality, for at least 30 days immediately prior to the date set for the nomination period.
3. Not indebted to the Council for any arrears of taxes or other charges.
4. Not otherwise disqualified under the Municipal Elections Act.
