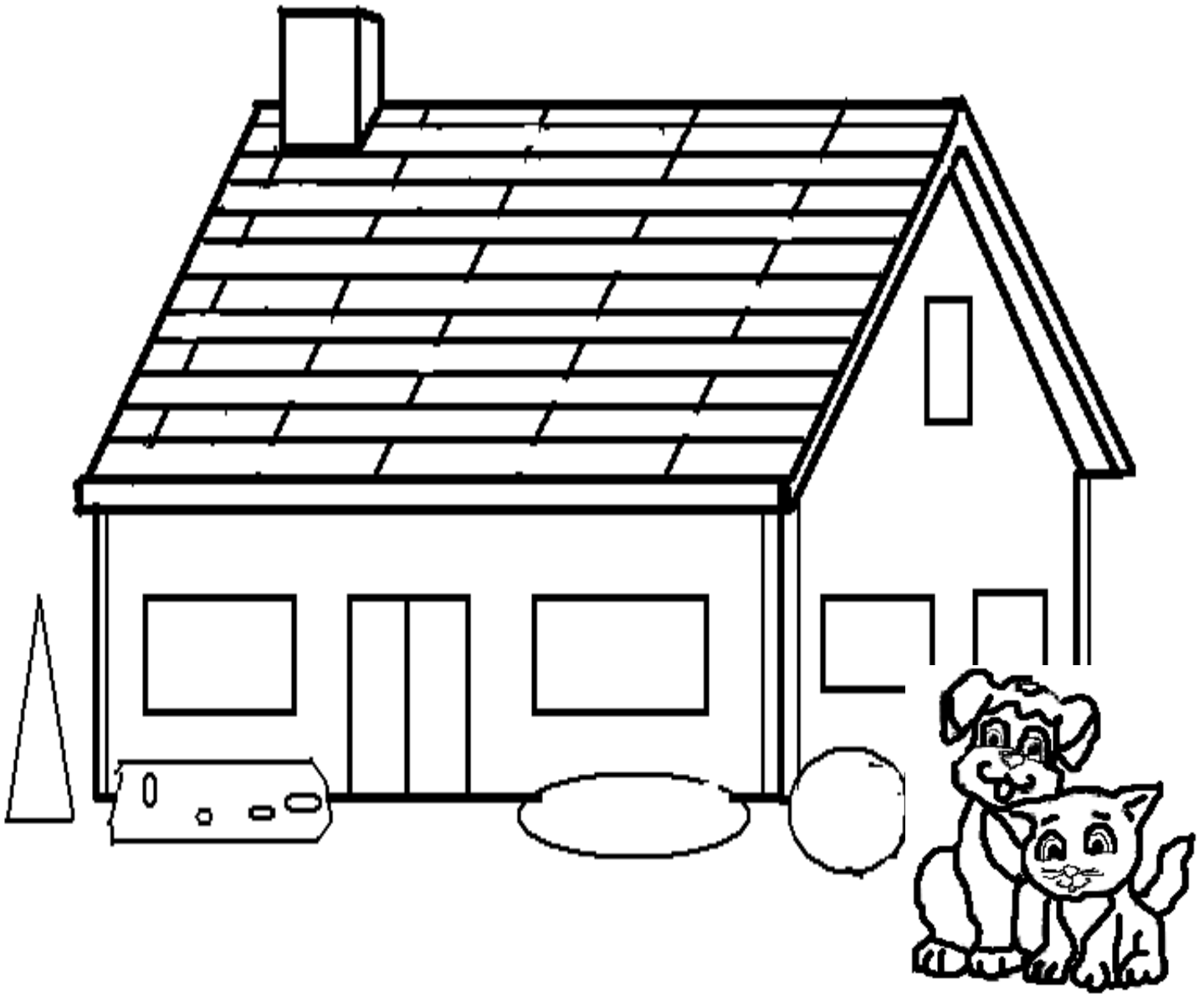

HOME EXIT DRILL

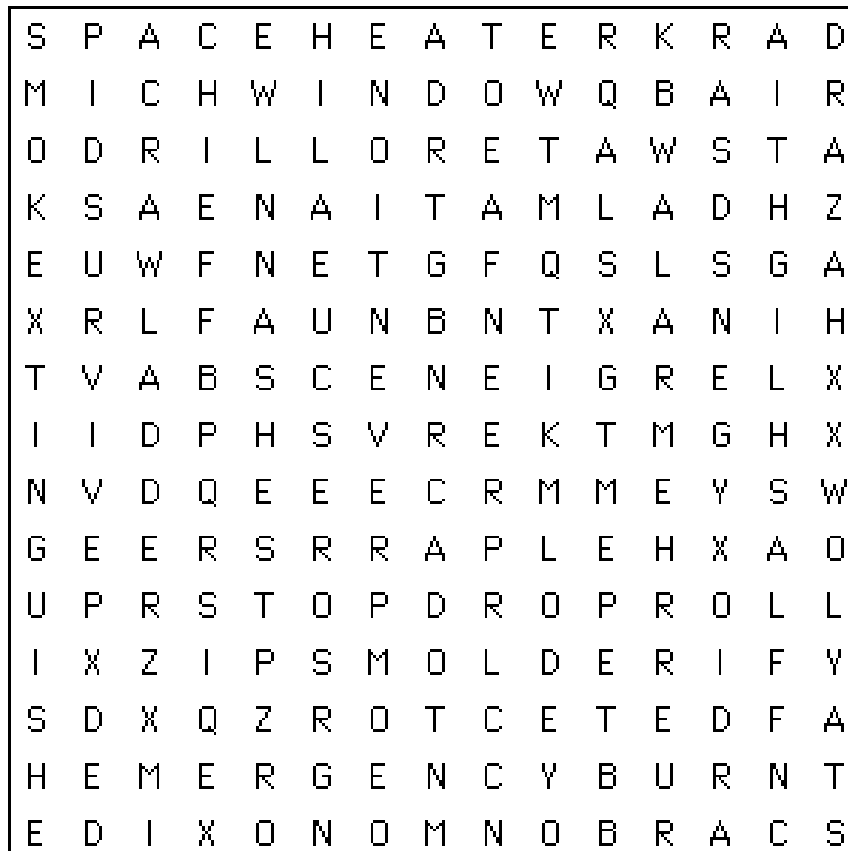


Klifford and Koko said

Fire Safety Word Search

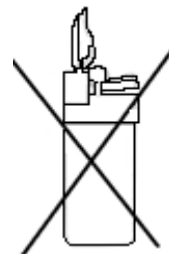
If you find matches or lighters, give them to an adult. If you see kids playing with matches or lighters, go tell an adult. Find other things you important items you should know about fire.

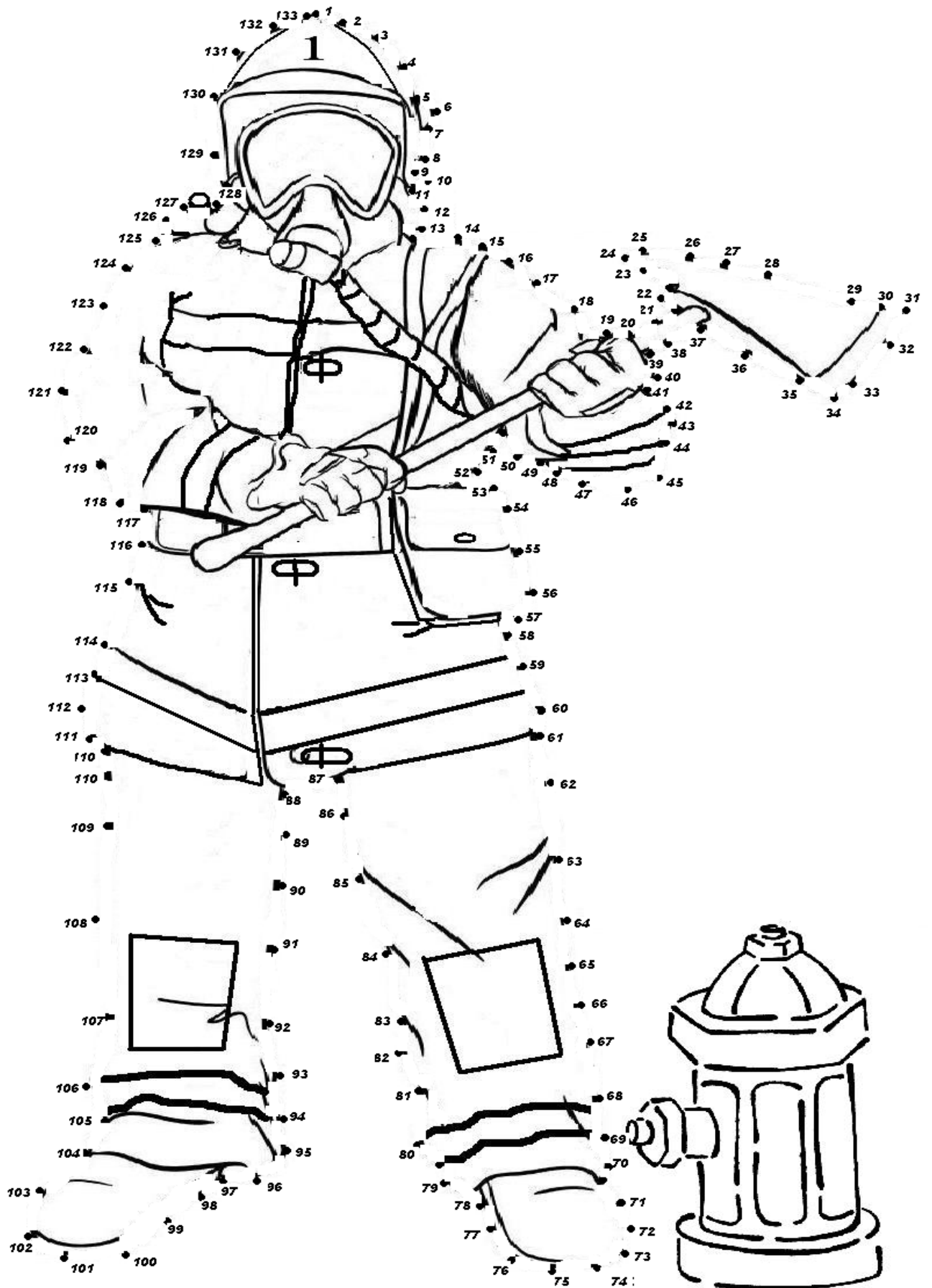


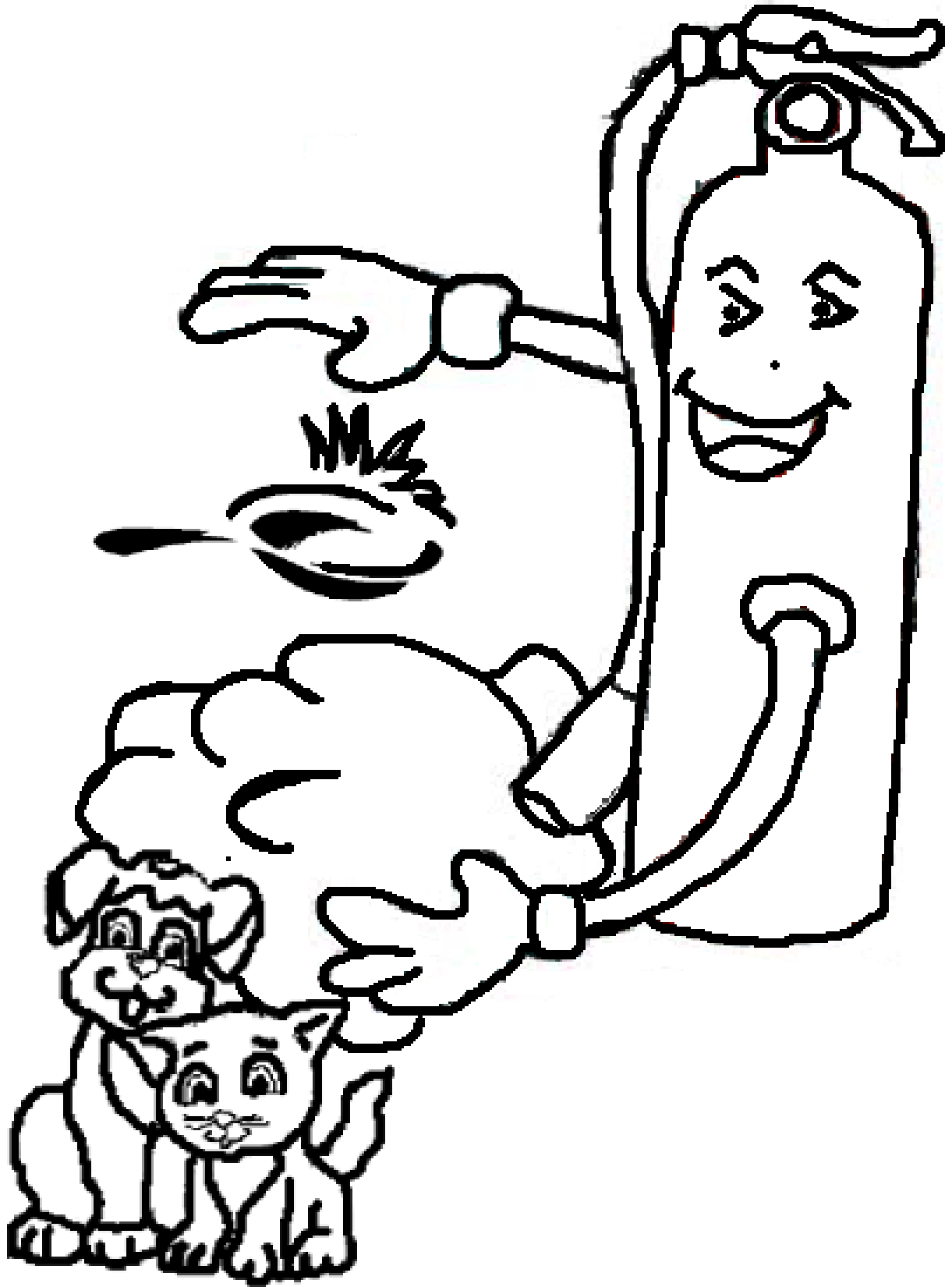
Klifford's and Koko's smoke detector



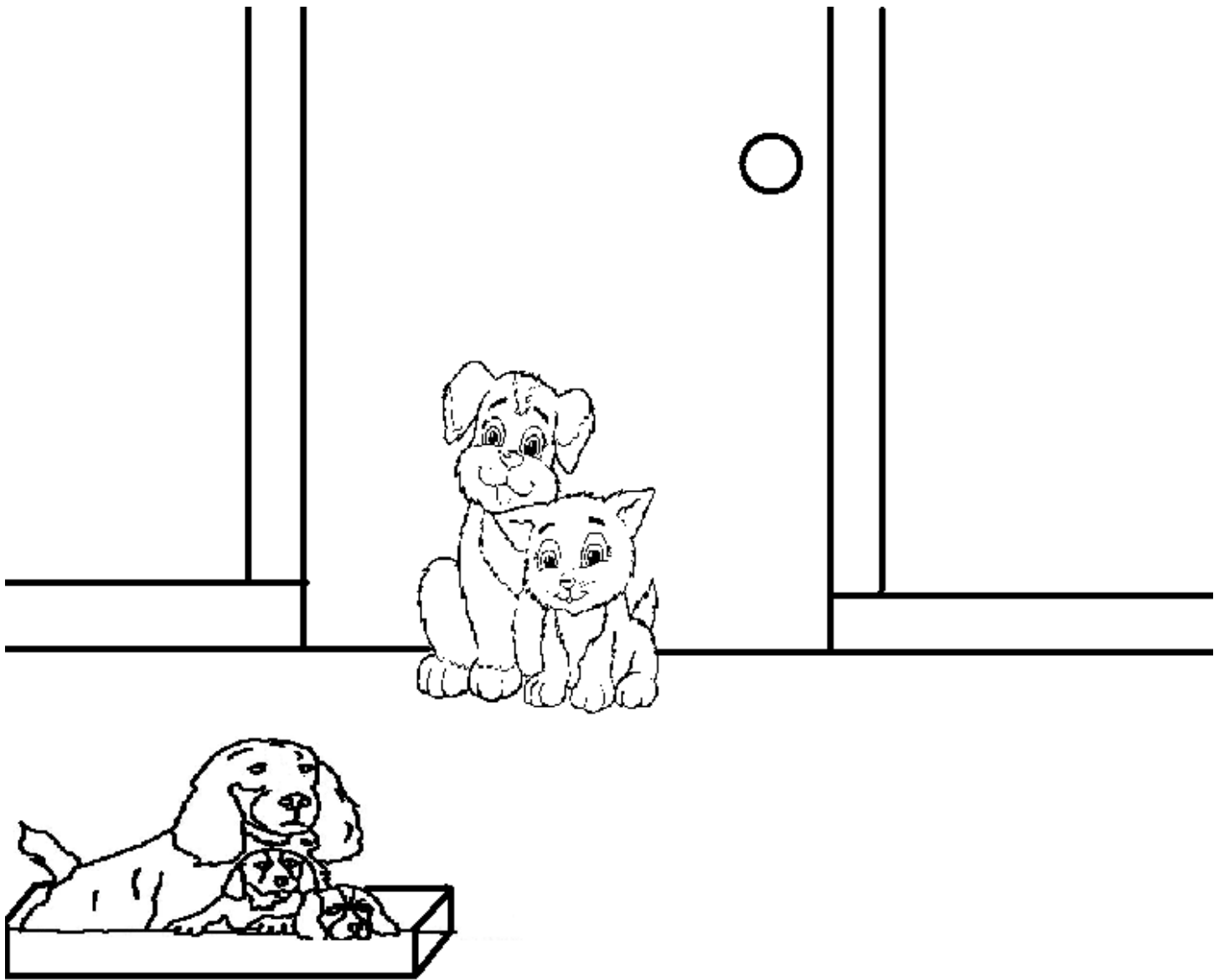
Klifford and Koko said it's a good idea to have at least one smoke detector in every bedroom to warn you in case of a fire.

DOT TO DOT



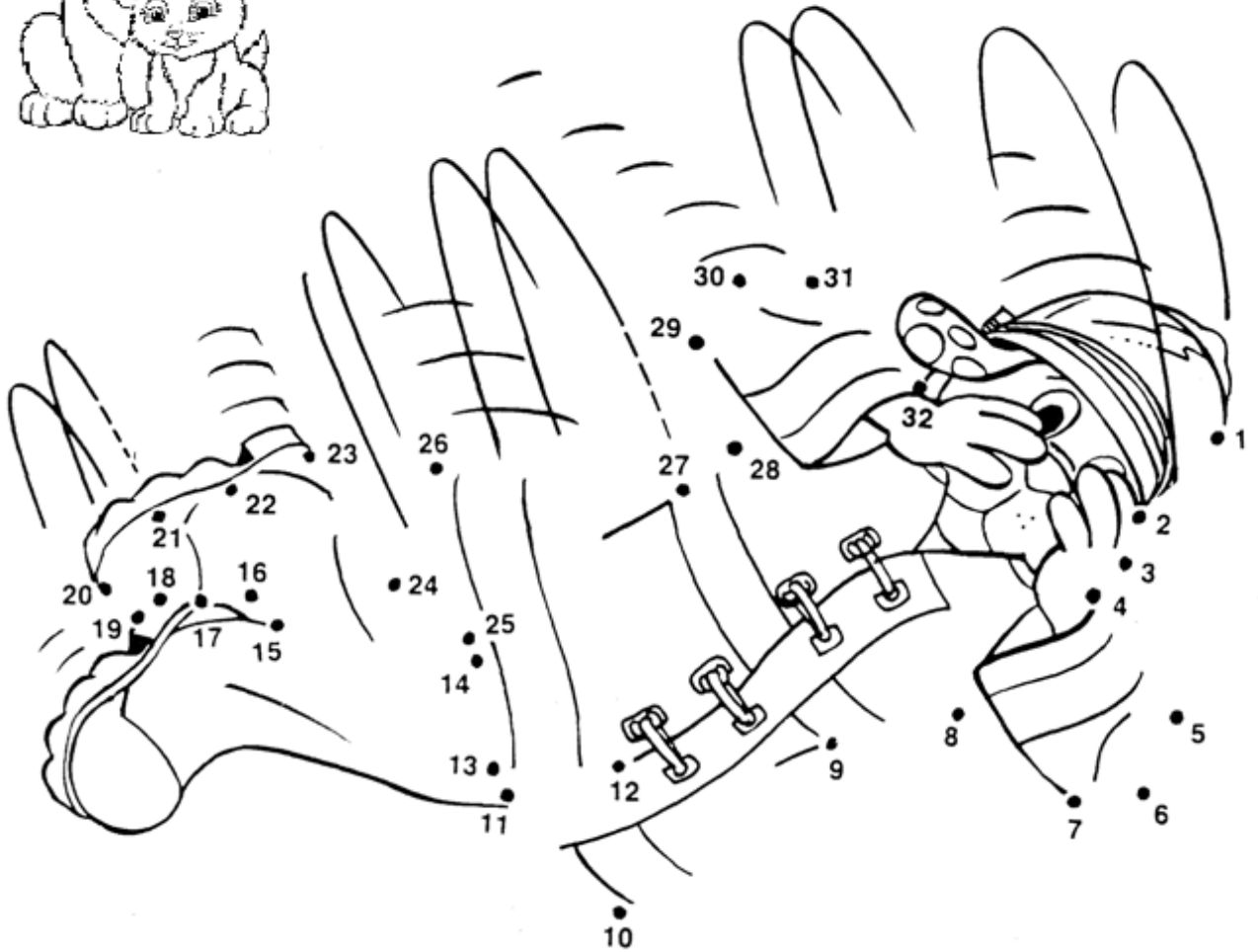


Klifford and Koko said that every home should have a fire extinguisher, and every member in the family should know how to use it

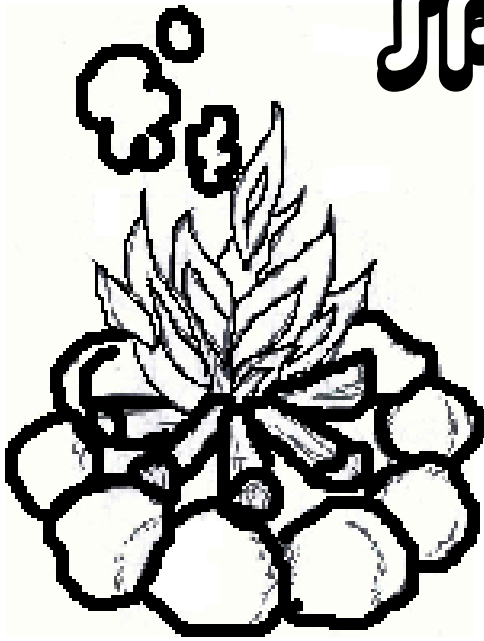
CONNECT THE DOTS.



IF YOU CATCH FIRE, STOP, DROP, AND ROLL! THIS PUTS THE FLAMES OUT.



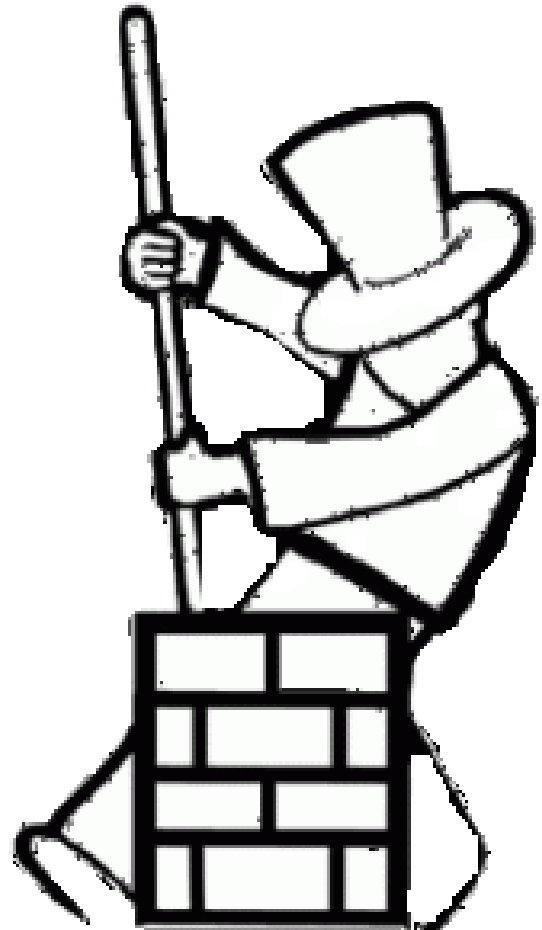
SAFETY TIPS

is out before leaving camp.

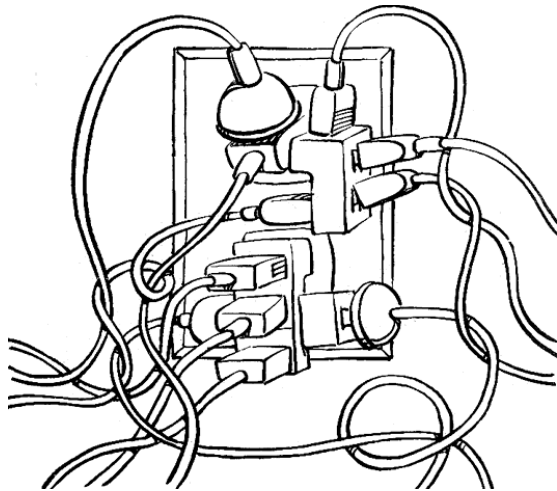


Keep leaf and trash fires under control

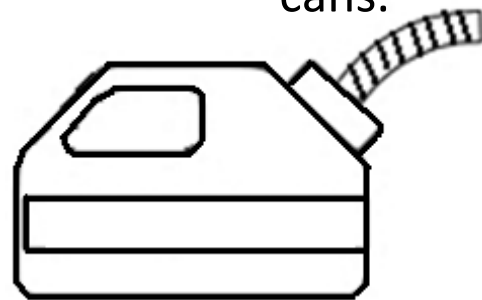


Keep your chimney

Store flammables in marked safety cans.

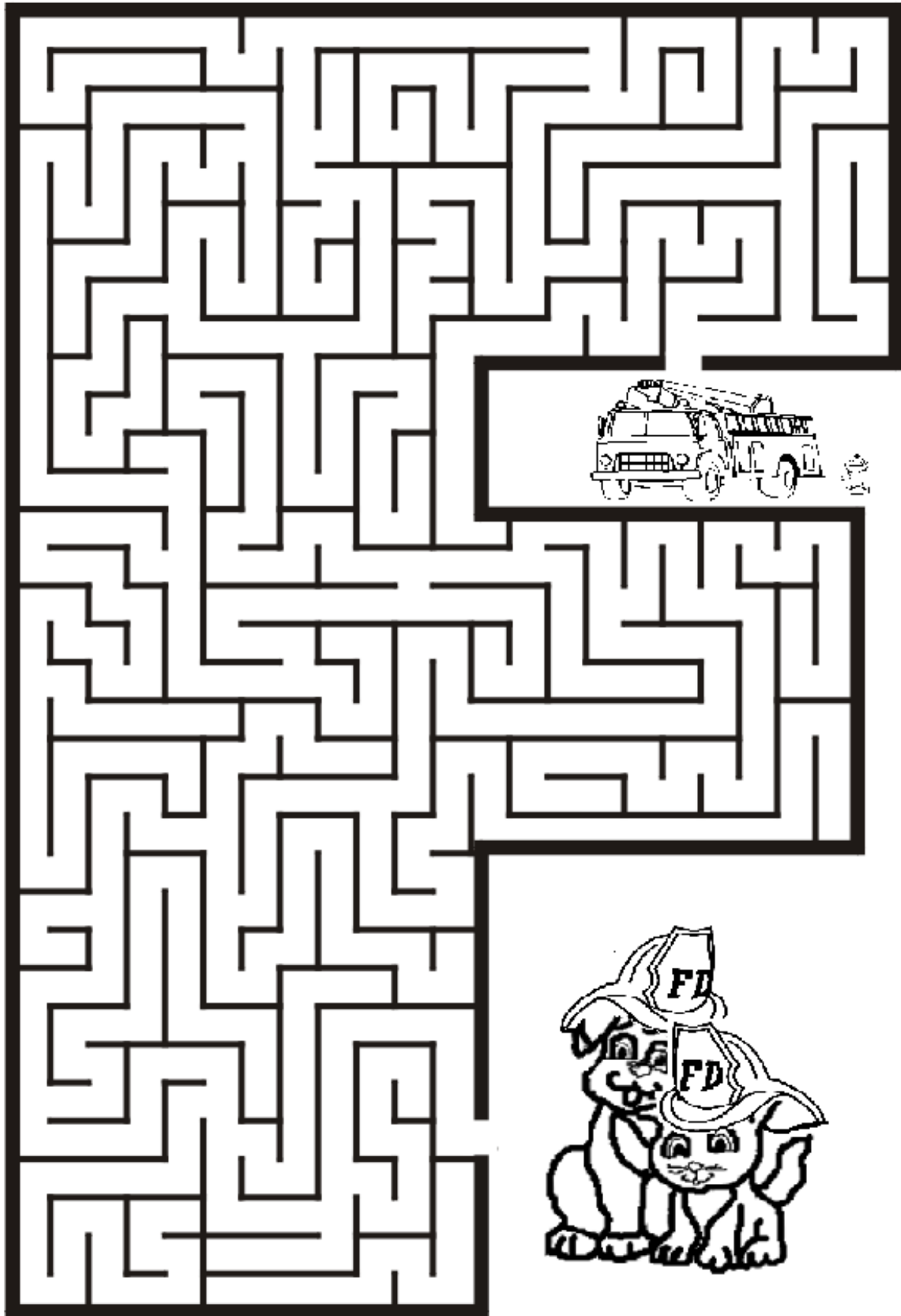


Make sure that electrical cords in your home are in good condition. Don't put too many plugs in one outlet.



Check Christmas lights for faulty wiring. Do not place a tree near a heat source such as fireplace or electrical heaters.

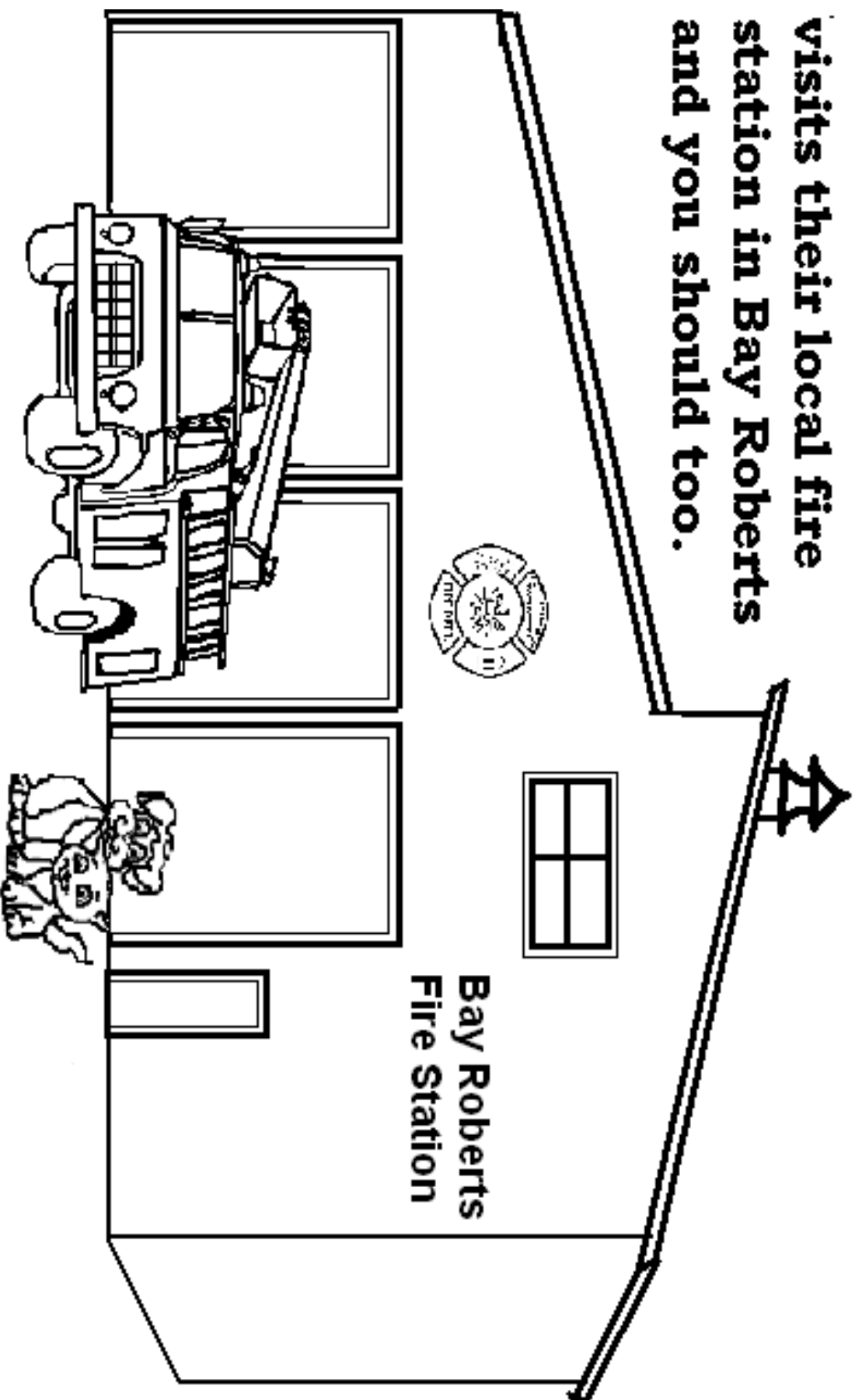

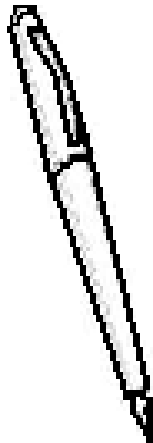
