



UNDER CONTROL - Twelve members of the Bay Roberts Volunteer Fire Department fought to keep control of the smoking brush on Country Road Friday, May 1. About an acre and a half burned in the hour and a half it took firefighters to control the flames, said Fire Chief Newman Parsons. The fire department received extra help from a Department of Forestry water bomber - until it was dispatched to another fire in Burnt Head Cupids. The Country Road fire reportedly started after a cigarette was carelessly tossed to the ground. Both incidents are currently under investigation.
