Christmas Tree Safety Tips A A A



• Choose a tree with fresh, green needles that do not fall off when touched

Placing The Tree:

- Before placing the tree in a stand, cut 2" from the base of the trunk
- Make sure the tree is at least 3 feet away from a heat
- Make sure the tree is not blocking an exit

Lighting The Tree:

- Use lights that are CSA approved
- Replace any broken lights
- Never use lit candles to decorate the tree
- Always turn off lights before leaving home or going to bed

After Christmas

• Get rid of the tree after Christmas or when it is dry. Dried out trees are a fire hazard & should be disposed of appropriately

Traffic Safety Tips



- · Respect posted speed limits
- Fire lanes **must be kept clear**, not only for emergency vehicles but also for reducing the likelihood of a vehicle/pedestrian collision
- Follow & obey all traffic signs
- Do not park as to obstruct visibility of a roadway/intersection
- Drive respectfully we all want to get where we're going safelv!
- Never operate or allow another person to operate a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol/drugs.
