Daytime Parade Route Guide

Daytime Parade will start at the Fire Hall parking lot, continue on Water Street, turn right at the lights on Conception Bay Highway and continue to Ascension. **Please make arrangements for participants to be picked up at the Ascension parking lot after the parade ends.**

- Please **do not block streets** when unloading
- All float entrants **must enter the lineup from Mosdells Lane off of Central Street**
- All floats are to have their company or organization name prominently displayed on the **front** of their vehicle for judging
- **All parade participants will meet on the Ascension Collegiate parking lot to be bussed to parade start site**
- Please read and adhere to the attached parade guidelines
- **In case of inclement weather, the parade will be held on the following Sunday, December 3rd, 2023.**

Nighttime Illumination Parade Route Guide

Nighttime illumination parade will start at the Fire Hall parking lot, continue down Water Street and finish at the Royal Canadian Legion. **Please make arrangements for participants to be picked up at the Legion parking lot after the parade ends.** All entrants are invited to enjoy hot chocolate at Santa's Christmas Park at the Bay Roberts Gardens.

Parade Guidelines

1. Cancellation

Daytime Parade: In the event of inclement weather, an announcement regarding cancellation and rescheduling will be made on VOXM and posted on the Town of Bay Roberts website and Facebook pages by 7am on parade day (December 2). The daytime parade will be rescheduled for the following Sunday (December 3rd, 2023).

Nighttime Parade: In the event of inclement weather, the nighttime parade scheduled for December 3rd at 6:30pm will be **cancelled**. An announcement will be made on the Town website and Facebook pages by 5pm.

2. Participants

Daytime Parade: All parade participants, excluding actual floats, need to meet on

the Ascension Collegiate parking lot at 8:30am to begin bussing to the parade start site.

Nighttime Parade: All parade participants, including floats, must enter the lineup through Mosdells Lane off of Central Street at 6:00pm to begin lining up the parade.

3. Treats

- a. Organizers prohibit the throwing of candies and/or promotional materials. If your group would like to pass out candies and/or approved promotional materials, it must be done person-to-person only.
- b. When handing out treats, please keep the pace of the parade. Failure to do so may result in a parade marshal asking you to stop.

4. Floats

- a. All floats are to have their company or organization name prominently displayed on the **front** of their vehicle for judging
- b. All floats must be of proper construction to prevent any chance of breakdown during the parade and have proper vision for the driver as well as ventilation. Drivers must remain with their floats.
- c. No one may get on or off a float once it has started on the parade route.
- d. All entrants should make use of Christmas lighting and be decorated in keeping with the parade theme.
- e. In the illumination parade, **floats must be lit with Christmas lighting** to participate.
- f. Festive music is encouraged on the floats.
- g. At the end of the parade route, **all floats must exit onto the Ascension Collegiate parking lot. There will be no stopping/offloading allowed on the Conception Bay Highway.**
- h. **Daytime:** All entrants **must make arrangements with the float participants to be picked up at the Ascension Collegiate parking lot or an area of your choice.**
Nighttime: All entrants **must make arrangements with the float participants to be picked up at the Legion parking lot or an area of your choice.**

5. Solicitation

There will be **no** solicitation for cash and/or ticket sales along the parade route. Only one food drive pick-up will be permitted.

6. Sensory Zone

Daytime: There will be a quiet/sensory zone with no music or sirens from Flooring & More to Fortune Restaurant.
