Parade Route Guide

The Klondyke Days Parade will start at the Fire Hall parking lot, continue on Water Street, turn right Cross Road, continue and turn right at Station Road then conclude at the Wilbur Sparkes Recreation Complex.

- Please **do not block streets** when unloading
- All float entrants **must enter the lineup from Mosdells Lane off of Central Street**
- Please read and adhere to the attached parade guidelines
- **In case of inclement weather, the parade will be postponed until Thursday, July 24 at 6:30pm.**

Parade Guidelines

1. Cancellation

In the event of inclement weather, the parade scheduled for July 23rd at 6:30pm will be **postponed until Thursday, July 24 at 6:30pm**. An announcement will be made on the Town website, Facebook pages, and Voyent Alert! by 5pm.

2. Floats

- a. All floats must be of proper construction to prevent any chance of breakdown during the parade and have proper vision for the driver as well as ventilation. Drivers must remain with their floats.
- b. No one may get on or off a float once it has started on the parade route.
- c. Music is encouraged on floats.

3. Solicitation

There will be **no** solicitation for cash and/or ticket sales along the parade route. Only one food drive pick-up will be permitted.
